 - Use *My Big Book of Catholic Bible Stories* (pages 44-47 “Let My People Go!” and “The Passover”)
 - Passover is the celebration of the Israelites being freed from slavery and the Hebrew children being spared from death
- IV. 6:45 – 7:10 The Way of the Cross Sarah
- Why did Jesus choose the date of the Jewish Passover for his death and Resurrection?
 - Turn to Youcat 95 and read together
 - Passion Narrative is read every year at Mass...what’s the name of that liturgy or that Sunday?
 - Pass out Way of the Cross booklets
 - We will pray the Way of the Cross together to contemplate Jesus’ passion and death.
- V. 7:10 – 7:20 Resurrection Sarah
- But it didn’t end with Jesus’ death! That’s what makes Christianity different!
 - What followed his death?
 - What’s that Sunday called?
 - Is there proof that the Resurrection happened?

PALM Sunday or PASSION Sunday is when we hear the Passion Narrative read during Mass. This is the Sunday BEFORE Easter.

The week after Palm Sunday is HOLY WEEK.

GOOD FRIDAY is the day Jesus died on the Cross.

The WAY OF THE CROSS is a prayer that meditates on Jesus' suffering and death and is usually prayed on the Fridays of Lent.

EASTER is the celebration of Jesus' Resurrection.

The Paschal Mystery = PASSION + DEATH + RESURRECTION + ASCENSION
