 - His life was a prayer
 - He withdrew, spent time by himself
- What does it mean to learn from Jesus how to pray? Youcat 477
 - Be watchful
 - Strive for purity of heart
 - Give up everything
 - Forgive enemies
 - Trust boldly in God
 - Love God above all things
- Does God hear our prayers? Youcat 478
 - So, does he?
 - He doesn't always say yes
 - God can always bring good from any situation, but it requires our participation, our openness to his will
- Story of Jairus and his daughter: Mark 5:21-43

- Jesus did one better than healing Jairus's daughter: he raised her from the dead!
